As a level 3 krew member there are a some important roles and responsibilities we expect you to follow for you to maintain the level and be promoted further.

As a more experienced krew member we expect you to follow the following.

- · You must follow all the 'Rules & Expectations' at all times when representing Krown Krew
- Must be capable of leading a team as Krew Chief if needed.
- You must be a more advanced helping hand for newer recruits (level 1 & 2) who need assistance
- You must be good at responding when you have been contacted and doing the things required to make the business run as smoothly as possible
- · Always in correct uniform
- Must help enforce our key principles: Professionalism, Reliability and well trained krew
- You notify the krew and office about anything you know the company would not approve

What's next: Level 4

In order to be promoted to level 4 krew. Please follow the key points below.

- Must at completed at least 1,000 hours with the company or be previously experienced elsewhere to be promoted sooner
- You always do the things expected and asked of the company
- You must be able to be team leader (Krew Chief). This means having enough experience
 with this company to know how we like it to run and operate. Enforcing this to other
 recruits and helping us keep our high standards to be unlike any other crew in Denmark.
- You must be able to help train new recruits with basics. Show and tell them what to do and how to do it
- You notify the krew and office of anything the company would not approve of
